



Call for Papers

Split – Hvar-Korcula, September 24 – 26, 2009

The 17th International Conference on Software, Telecommunications and Computer Networks (*SoftCOM 2009*), co-sponsored by the IEEE Communication Society (ComSoc), will be held in attractive ambience of the Amfora hotel in Hvar, September 24 - 26.
